Buffalo City TVET College invites experienced service providers to tender for the provision of Online application, Registration and Learner Management System and Service for Buffalo City TVET College.

Short - listed suppliers could be invited for a presentation.

Tender documents will be available as from 14H00 on Monday, 05 September 2022 at the Procurement office of the Buffalo City TVET College, Admin Centre, Comer Lukin & King Street, in East London. One original + 1 memory stick / USB must be submitted with your application. Completed documents and USB should be placed in a sealed envelope endorsed "LMS System - SCM 3/08/22" must be deposited in the Box, Buffalo City TVET College, Admin Centre, Corner Lukin & King Street, East London, not later than 11H00 on Monday, 19 September 2022.

A non-refundable bid deposit of R200.00 required on collection of the bid documents and must be deposited into Buffalo City TVET College, ABSA BANK, Account Number:405 4285 355. Ref No: 2022TEND13E

Bidders shall take note of the following bid conditions:

Late bids will not be accepted. Failure to complete all supplementary information may result in the bid being deemed null and void (eliminated). Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) principles shall apply.

Bids will be evaluated as follows:

Stage 1: Mandatory requirements

Preliminary stage: Checking compliance and documentation. Bidders will be disqualified as per the elimination criteria mentioned in the bid documentation.

Stage 2: Functionality

Bidders must score a minimum of 70% and above for functionality in order to proceed to stage 3. Bidders who score less than 70% will not proceed to stage 3.

Stage 3: Price and BBBEE

The 80 points will be allocated for price and 20 points for B-BBEE status level (B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL CONTRIBUTOR — Original or an original certified B-BBEE status level verification certificate must be submitted in order to qualify for preference points for B-BBEE as per the revised PPPFA regulation of 2017. Please note: A sworn affidavit in terms of the amended B-BBEE codes will also be accepted for deemed exempted micro enter (EME) and Qualifying enterprise (QSE). 100 Total Points.

Submission of tenders will be deemed to indicate that the tenderer has accepted the tender adjudication procedures and principles as contained in the bid documents.

All agreement awarded as a result of this process will be covered by the General Conditions of Contract (www.treasury.gov.za).

Please note: Compulsory Briefing Session will take place on Wednesday; 07 September 2022 at the Council Chamber in East London Campus at 12H00. Bid forms that are incomplete or incorrect will result in the disqualification of that application. Suppliers are requested to be registered for VAT and must submit a copy of SARS Tax Clearance Certificate with a pin in their application.

Telegraphic, email, telexed or faxed bids will not be considered. The college reserves the right to cancel the bid not to accept the lowest bid offered and also not to award in terms of this process.
